Participation conditions

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted. The registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment in full. Please ensure that the full tuition fee is received in our account. If the maximum capacity of participants is reached, the organizers reserve the right to refuse any further registrations.

Cancellation Policy

Notification of cancellation must be made in writing via email to the organizers. The notification must include all the relevant information regarding the bank account to which the refund will be remitted.

Cancellation Fees

If the written notification of cancellation is received by June 14, 2021, 75% of the course fees received for the Intercultural Trainer Academy will be reimbursed.

We regret that no refunds will be made for cancellations after June 14, 2021. Refund requests will only be processed after the Intercultural Trainer Academy.

Cancellation of the Intercultural Trainer Academy
